Criteria for Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be the son, daughter or dependant of an active member of the Vallejo Education Association.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating senior in high school for the current academic year (midyear graduates are eligible.)
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average, using the University of California GPA system.
- 4. Applicant must submit a completed Scholarship Application form, along with letters of recommendations and high school transcript(s) covering sophomore, junior, and senior years (to date of application).
- 5. Applicant must also be available for an interview.
- 6. Applicant must intend to enter an accredited college or university. **NOTE:** Scholarship funds will be remitted to the college or university upon verification of enrollment.
